A large clock made by J. Colomb & Co., provided by Tamaoki Tokeiten in 1908

This clock was assembled and sold by a Swiss clock company, J. Colomb & Co. in Yokohama. The mechanical part of the clock is the Comtoise Clock manufactured in Franche-Comte in France near the Swiss border and the wooden part is made of Japanese zelkova in Japan.
